

Copyright Notices

Authors transfer the right to the University Library of the Bauhaus-University Weimar to save the document, to publish the document on the Internet and that the document may be converted into another format. This applies to the server of the German National Library as well as other document server with regard to content or regional aspects.

In addition to this for doctoral and habilitation theses the author confirms that the publication is accepted by the PhD Committee and consistent with the version approved for print and consistent with the delivered print issues.

The German copyright (Urheberrechtsgesetz (UrhG)) applies to documents provided electronically in data networks.

In particular, the following applies:
